RESETTING LIFT EQUIPPED WITH VELOCITY FUSES

If the lift will not come down and has velocity fuses:

- Shut off the down flow control valve.
- Energize the motor, (this may require the limit switch to be disconnected).
- After steps one and two are completed, press the down button that energizes the
 down valve coil. Open the down flow control valve an eighth of an inch of a turn. This
 will allow a gentle flow of oil to return back to the tank without the velocity fuse
 locking up again.
- Re-set the limit switch so that the lift stops before the lower rollers make contact with the mechanical stops, or the cylinder bottoms out.
