## CENTER SCISSOR PIN REPLACEMENT

- Raise the machine and place maintenance devices into place accordance with the instructions in your owner's manual.
- Lower the lift onto the maintenance devices, depress the down control button a couple of times to release the hydraulic pressure from the system.
- The top should be secured for safety reasons. There are several ways to secure the top:
  - a. If an overhead crane is available, hook a chain to the top of both ends.
  - b. If a forklift is available, the forks can be placed in beside the leg set and take any strain off the leg set.
  - c. Cut 4X4's (wood) and position them at the furthest point from each other under the top.
- Drive two steel wedges in between the scissors legs adjacent to the center scissors pin, spreading the legs slightly.
- Clamp the legs together with large "C" clamps securing the alignment of the legs to the center pin.
- Remove the shaft retainer, (grind off the washer welded to the end of the shaft or unbolt a washer bolted to the end of the shaft, or remove a snap ring depending on the design of the lift).
- Drive the center pin out of one side at a time. Replace the bushings, one side at a time. Always leave a pin in the side not being worked on. In the event that the pin has worn and a ridge is present, turn the pin 180 degrees and then remove the pin.
- Lubricate bushings and center washers with multi-purpose grease.

- Install the new shaft and spacer washers.
- Remove clamps and wedges.
- Install outer washers and snap rings.
- Run the lift up slightly and remove maintenance devises and other support.
- Cycle the lift and check for smooth operation and proper tracking of rollers on the roller track.
