Replacing an Air Motor with Gast

DISASSEMBLEY OF AN EXISTING POWER UNIT:

- 1. Disconnect the air hose from the motor located at the elbow on the back of the motor.
- 2. Remove the steel tubing from the pump fittings and the down valve.
- 3. Remove the suction hose from the tank and the pump. The fittings on the suction hose are reusable.
- 4. Disconnect the hydraulic cylinder hose from the pump.
- 5. Unbolt the motor from the tank and remove motor and pump.

REASSEMBLEY:

- 1. Mount the new motor to the pump.
- 2. Grind off existing mounting studs.
- 3. Attach new mounting plate to the motor with nuts and lock washers.
- 4. Position and tack weld the new mounting plate to the tank.
- 5. Install the new hose assembly in place of the tubing that runs from the pump to the down valve.
- 6. Install the new suction hose using the existing reusable fittings.
